



Step 1 Visit leaders' crib and notes

St James Graveyard investigation Instructions for group leaders

- Choose someone to be in charge of filling in the fact file matrix as you walk around (NB not every grave will have all the information for each box).
- Before you set off, get the children relate the trail map to their surroundings – e.g. use the main road and gates or the church shape to orientate themselves and find the direction to follow to their first gravestone.
- Be aware that some children will get very excited and want to rush on, but try to keep your group close to you and on task. Remind them of any safety rules issued.
- Make sure that all the children can get close enough to each gravestone to read what's on it (this may need them to take turns).
- If necessary, use the crib to help children decipher words (some are hard to read).
- Take your time but keep a check on the time, as you need to visit all six gravestones.

Below is what is written on each grave. Use this crib if you cannot decipher the inscriptions.
